PETg-LV (polyethylene terephthalate glycol - low versatile)

- much lower shrink force
- excellent scuff resistance
- high percentage of shrink
- easily recycled, environmentally friendly

OPS (oriented polystyrene)

- most controlled shrink curve
- cost effective
- often used for "squeeze" applications

PLA (polylactic acid)

- corn-based substrate
- compostable, environmentally friendly

We are presently developing web offset solutions using:

PVC (polyvinyl chloride)

- Cost effective
- Good scuff resistance

PETg (white film)

- High-yield film
